Visitors will have the opportunity to tour open studios, homes, garages, and outdoor spaces to experience the creative process firsthand and purchase artwork directly from local artists.

The event, organized by southwest Denver [artist/designer/genealogist Shokai Sinclair](#), is supported by a grant from the [Denver Community Active Living Coalition](#) to encourage walkability and eco-friendly engagement in the neighborhood.
